ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE PUBLIC MEETING FOR  
TRANSCONTINENTAL GAS PIPE LINE COMPANY, LLC  
TITLE V SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION APPLICATION

Pursuant to NJS 13:1D-157 and in accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Administrative Order 2021-25, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC (Transco), will hold a public information session for the purpose of receiving oral and/or written comments on its Title V significant modification application, permit number BOP 220001 for its LNG Plant Station 240 facility located at 718 Paterson Plank Rd, Carlstadt, NJ, 07072 (The Facility). The Facility will host a public information session via [Webex](#) regarding the application at 6:00 – 8:00pm on August 22, 2023.

This permit application is to replace the Facility's four (4) existing natural gas heaters with four (4) new lower-emitting natural gas fired heaters that will be compliant with NJDEP NOx emission standards. The existing heaters each operate under an United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) approved NOx Alternative Emission Limit (AEL) that will expire on July 9, 2024. Transco is requesting to replace these units with new heaters equipped with state-of-the-art burner technology that reduces the potential emission rates from the Facility. Existing permit requirements that limit the annual operating runtime for the heaters will be retained.

LNG Plant Station 240 serves as a key component of Transco's interstate natural gas transmission pipeline that is critical to supporting the region's energy needs for millions of residents, businesses, and organizations. As such, the proposed air permit will retain the existing equipment in the Title V permit until they are permanently retired prior to in-service of the new sources.
